## Fall Sports Physicals

The required Athletic Packet is available in the main office at East Hanover Middle School, Florham Park Middle School, Hanover Park High School or online at [www.hanoverpark.org](http://www.hanoverpark.org).

All students wishing to participate in athletics at Hanover Park High School must have a completed physical within 365 days of the start of the season and submit the necessary paperwork in order to be eligible. Athletic physicals for fall participation can be performed by either a private physician or the Hanover Park school physician on the date listed below (No appointment is necessary).

Wednesday, June 22, 2011

Boys - 12:00 – 1:30 p.m.

Girls - 2:00 – 3:30 p.m.

## Note: School physicals are no longer held in August.

- If an athlete is participating in the school physicals, all information in the Athletic Packet needs to be completed prior to arrival.
- Students having a physical with a private physician must turn in the Athletic Packet in its entirety to Hanover Park Central Office by August 2<sup>nd</sup>. Forms handed in after August 2<sup>nd</sup> will be reviewed by the school doctor on a weekly basis. **It can take up to one week for the school to receive approval allowing the athlete to begin practice.**
- If you have any questions please call the athletic office at Hanover Park at 973-887-3004.
- Availability of athletic team levels (Varsity, Junior Varsity and Freshman) will be dependent upon sufficient student registration and eligibility.
- All physicals before each season will be offered at Hanover Park with official notification of dates through the principal and nurse's offices, with postings and morning announcements.
- If you choose to have your family physician perform the physical, please keep in mind that our Board of Education policy is to then have our physician sign off on your doctor's physical form. Once our doctor completes this process, then the athlete may begin practice.
- Six (6) days of practice are required by the NJSIAA after the physical before the athlete can participate in any scrimmage or game.
- Any athlete who participates in any of our sports programs must participate in his/her physical education class in order to be eligible for practice, scrimmages and games.
