STATE RECOGNITION: *New Jersey Monthly* again named Hanover Park as one of the "Top 100 High Schools in New Jersey." (August 2010)

ACADEMIC DECATHLON COMPETITION: The Academic Team placed first in the North Jersey Group 2 Regional Competition and finished 7th overall in the state competition.

ADVANCED PLACEMENT: 192 AP tests were administered - 80 percent of the scores received were a 3 or better. 29 students have received AP recognition by the College Board - 17 students were named AP Scholars; 5 students were named AP Scholars with Honor; 6 students were named AP Scholars with Distinction and 1 student was named National AP Scholar.

ART: 7 students had their artwork accepted into the Blackwell Street Art Show and 11 students had their artwork accepted into the 6th Annual Caldwell College Teen Arts Jam.

ATHLETICS: Hanover Park High School's Girl's Basketball Team was North II Group II State Sectional Champions. The Park Hockey Team won the Haas Cup. Conference championships were won in Baseball, Boy's Spring Track, Golf and Wrestling. In Winter Track, 1 student was crowned Morris County Champion. In Spring Track, 2 students were crowned Morris County Champions and 1 student was crowned Group 2 State Champion. The Freshman Football team finished its season with an undefeated record. The Volleyball team was awarded the Sportsmanship Award for the NJAC Conference, Freedom Division.

FBLA COMPETITION: 13 students placed in the Future Business Leaders of America (FBLA) Northern New Jersey Regional Competition. 5 students placed at the State Leadership Conference, and 2 qualified to compete at the national level. Hanover Park's FBLA also took first place in the category of Largest Local Chapter- Northern Region.

MUSIC: 2 students were accepted into the New Jersey All State Chorus. 9 students were accepted into the North Jersey Regional Chorus. 1 student was accepted into the 2011 All Eastern Honor Choir and 1 student was accepted into the National Men's Honor Choir. At the Hershey Park Music in the Parks Festival, 1 student was honored as Outstanding Soloist, the Women's Choir rated Excellent, the Men's Choir rated Superior, and the Chamber singers rated Superior in Jazz/Swing Choir and Excellent in Mixed Choir.

PUBLICATIONS: The school newspaper, *The Forum*, received a first place award by the American Scholastic Press Association.

SCHOLARS: 5 students were National Merit Scholars; 5 students received National Merit Letters of Commendation; 21 students were recipients of the Presidential Academic Award of Excellence; 2 students were nominated to attend the 2011 Governor's School; 1 student was selected as a National Hispanic Recognition Program Scholar; 3 students were selected to the NJ Scholars Program; 1 student was named as a 2011 Presidential Scholar; 83 students were inducted into the Barbara Bradshaw Chapter of the National Honor Society. Ninety-three percent of the Class of 2011 will continue formal education.

SAT: Hanover Park has surpassed both the state and national average with a combined score in Math, Critical Reading, and Writing.
